(Most of the "deadwood" were players who came on the ladder, under the old rule, and who never played a match!)

How To Make Sense Out of the Ladder. An asterisk(*) after a match means that the challenger won. CAPITAL LETTERS means that this is a SENIOR (45 or over). Underlining means a new player or team. The letter (P) after a name means that this player has been penalized according to Rule A-8.
